About three months ago on a street night, one of the groups went out and shared the Word with a man who had recently been kicked out of the Jehovah's Witness church. The folks that shared with him tried to reason with him that Jesus is God, but on that score he would not budge. So we prayed that he would have a revelation of Jesus Christ for all that He is, and the man agreed to that, calling himself a truth-seeker. Well, just recently he came up to a couple of us at the end of street night in his wheel chair and explained that he had been given two visions from God, confirming the truth of Jesus Christ and His Word. At one point the man was playing piano and began singing and the Holy Spirit came upon him in power so that he sang in tongues and he said it was more his music than anything he'd ever written himself. He explained that this was because when a person loses themselves in Jesus they find themselves all the more. **He praised**

One of the ideas we've been praying about is to expand the house church model and focus more on plugging our friends into house churches. The Jesus Gathering is often draining for the leadership, but we still think it vital to have some kind of larger gathering for folks to come to. Yet we wonder how we could make it more life-giving to all involved. Please keep us in prayer as we seek to discern these things.
