The third and final test for Timothy and Morgan's baby came back to confirm it is a complete healing! We are so thankful for that and all that Timothy and I learned in India. **Now we take what we learned in India and apply to our ministry here!**

More funds have come in for the ministry van to our friends in Ongole, India. Much more is needed to **if it's on your heart, write checks to Envision Mission and put "India" in the memo line.** If you give online make sure you put "India" in the notes, so we know what it's intended for. Thanks to all who have given towards that so far! We are  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way to our minimum goal of \$10,000 towards the van.

**The biggest thing we've learned so far has been about prayer, so please join us in praying.** We're going through a season of being pruned, but we believe it is for more fruitful ministry. It's so vital to walk by faith and not by sight, so we won't be discouraged. Much of the team has been under spiritual attack, but we press on. We try to discern how best to minister to folks without enabling them towards inaction themselves.

We pray with folks, share the Word and the Gospel as often as possible, whether at the Jesus Study, in house churches, at street night or at men's and ladies' groups. Whether through deliverance from demons, praying with addicts to be set free, praying for healing, or just a listening ear, doors are opened for us to share Christ and in this we rejoice! **A young man and his family would like to take baptism classes this summer** as well, so pray that will happen and they will all eventually be baptized!

**YWAM will be joining us on street night in July with Rising Hope**, our street ministry being led by Jon Ng. We'll meet first at 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist on Tuesdays and then go out from there. Pray that we might bear much fruit with them!

**Mitchell will have the opportunity also to speak for the SERVE project** at 1<sup>st</sup> Christian Reformed Church to 51 youth from all over the country. The topic they chose: authentic community in Christ. Perfect! **It's been fun to visit churches also and speak about India, to preach and to lead worship. If that's something your church would like Mitchell or one of the staff to do, let us know.**

The house church network is in full swing to move out on its own in partnership with Envision. We are talking with a group of elders and pastors from local churches who would act as advisory elders. Mitchell will remain the lead elder of Envision Mission and ordained within the Christian Reformed Church but the house churches are seeking to establish as an inter-denominational network led by multiple elders. Mitchell would be one of those elders and Bernie Brower also. **Please pray for us through that process.** Once that is established pray that Envision can find creative ways to do outreach again.

**We're talking about doing a small open mic in the Fall at the Firehouse Coffeehouse in Fairhaven.** Also, in the Fall, Rising Hope would also like to do street night on Friday nights.
