Praise God that so far \$15,500 has come in with more pledges towards a ministry van for our friends in southeast India. **If it's on your heart to give more, write checks to Envision Mission and put "India" in the memo line.** If you give online make sure you put "India" in the notes, so we know what it's intended for. We just got word that one family wants to match gifts that come in from August through September of 2017, up to \$9,000, so that the maximum amount can be raised. YWAM has joined us! Rising Hope with Jon Ng leads the street nights with 7-10 students on Tuesday nights in downtown Bellingham. We are excited about this partnership in the Gospel and pray that God will use them and all of us mightily for His purposes. The first two Tuesdays have been a wonderful time of orientation for the students and they're excited to dig into the work in August.



On July 9, we had a Jesus Gathering Church picnic with several Lynden churches serving the food. A big thank you to all of you who came and served that night. At least one young man came to Christ there and many lives were touched as students served throughout Whatcom County that week, worshipped together, heard Mitchell's heart on authentic community in Christ and processed together in small groups. The house churches are strengthened by the Word, in fellowship and even in number. We are thankful that there are 3 of them and are still hoping this will form a network for other house churches to join. Mitchell is also excited to do more outreach in downtown Bellingham once these are well established. Pray for wisdom as we move forward with this.

Nick Potter has been facilitating the Men's group while Morgan West is away working at Camp Firwood. When he returns we plan to have him doing an internship with us full time for three months. Timothy Potter consistently leads the Jesus Study on Sunday night. Ted Gray and Mike Nelson are being raised up as elders at their house church. Bernie continues to lead the house church at Lincoln Square. Morgan Potter is our office assistant and Mitzie Crosser leads hospitality at the Jesus Gathering and for the Ladies' meetings once a month. **God has raised up leaders among us and we are so thankful for that!**
