We have prayed for years for one man to have housing and he finally has a studio apartment; another found a job as a prep cook. Another man took a Bible who is on probation from jail and heard the Word gladly. Some are not so glad to hear us, but we pray for all of them to find fellowship in Christ and His Church.

The Senti family had a much needed 4 week vacation, so many thanks for your prayers for them. Mitchell and Johnathon Senti went to Zuni, New Mexico where Mitchell preached and they came back after about 5 days. But then the Senti's waterline busted and they had to replace it, then their Dad passed away, and Rochelle got pneumonia and a sinus infection. So it wasn't the easiest 30 days off, but they are thankful for it nonetheless. Mitchell had some anxiety coming back in while still grieving, but God is strengthening him more and more daily. This ministry is difficult and it takes its toll on all of us as a staff, so pray also for Jon and Mitzie and Bernie. And pray for the Senti's to have some good rest and for healthy emotional strength as well as physical health. The Senti's plan to take a break at Cedar Springs as well. But also pray for protection from the evil one as the battle is not just emotional, but spiritual.
