God has not only opened the door for ministry at Bellingham Technical College, but is using Peter Rust to develop a leadership team to do ministry there. We are exploring campus ministry affiliation options as well. Pray for wisdom, provision and especially lasting fruit in the lives of students there.

Our intern **Jamie Sweet** has begun meeting with co-workers in a house church-like setting, has helped develop of our Jesus Study curriculum and is familiarizing himself with various Envision events like the Jesus Gathering. We are so thankful for him. **Pray for his strength** as he works a full time job, goes to school and works with us as an intern.

This month's Jesus Gathering included the graduation of three guys from our Summit house program: Mark Anderson, Mark Tarbell and Andrew Campbell. What a lot of work these guys have accomplished by the grace of God in Christ Jesus!

We have **one sponsor stepping forward already** and we'll let you know if and when we need more. The commitment could be as much as \$1500 for three months' sponsorship. If you're interested our preference would be that we introduce you to the person you sponsor, so that you can personally hear their story, and know the fellow you're investing in for the sake of Christ. Our friend **Jeff Grothe helps us with street night on the last Tuesday of every month**. He also leads a discipleship group on Saturday mornings and facilitates Multiply Bellingham, a house church/Kingdom growth community of practice that meets once a month. We are also thankful for him being part of our team. Pray for his strength as well.

We're still praying about doing a Jesus Study at Agate Heights Lake Whatcom Center once a month, also a clothes distribution time once a month on Tuesday nights, and what to do with the current Jesus Study on Wednesday nights. So please pray for wisdom about what to do with these ministries as well. Leadership is the main thing we need for these. All of this requires teamwork and we are seeing God raising this up, but pray it all comes to fruition. Mitzie, Bernie and our friend Missy are all praying about their involvement in these things as well.

We are also hiring for a new position related to our Summit House program: a **Summit House Ministry Director** would be a **full-time salaried position**. This position is for a community developer/ministry director that can engage the local churches in Whatcom County to meet the need of long-term discipleship housing for disenfranchised individuals who need help moving forward in their discipleship process. Through the development of Summit Houses this Ministry Director will work with local churches to not only disciple these men and women in one to three year housing programs, but help them thrive in the context of a local church and vocation. It will include fundraising and equipping communication with churches as well as closely working with us at Envision.
