Another thing we've learned: **One on ones are much easier** in work settings, so it's important to keep the focus on making disciples and not on having a consistent group meeting time. Discipleship can happen in the workplace as well, sometimes more so. But it's also good to share life outside of work with someone that you are discipling. And let them help disciple you too. What a joy our brother has been-thank you for continuing to pray for him as well.

Another brother who has volunteered with us, **Jeff Grothe**, **has also been appointed an elder and his house church** is fully functioning along with the Jesus Gathering network. He also helps Envision's BTC outreach and Street outreach. On the last Tuesday of the month he takes



the crew out, usually around Base Camp at the Lighthouse Mission, and leads ministry to the homeless there, sharing Christ and giving to needs that may present themselves. Keep him in prayer as well! Jeff and some of the crew pictured left singing on the streets.

Sometimes folks will receive prayer and help, sometimes not. One fellow told us that Jesus didn't come to save us but to show us the way to do it ourselves. When we shared with him further about our need for a Savior he got angry and insisted that we leave. But a father and son received us with gladness and even accepted our invitation to join us for worship that Sunday. We prayed together and fellowshipped right there on the streets.

Rochelle and I have continued sharing with our neighbors, offering to pray for them and asking about their concerns. It's been a very slow process, but God is helping us. We encourage y'all to do the same in your neighborhoods. See what the Lord can do through you!

Another outreach is starting to take shape for Bellingham Technical College. Peter Rust plans to do a podcast, both audio and video, and invite students to share their talents and be interviewed as well. The response has already been excellent, **but pray that doors remain open** and effective for that ministry as well.
