Pray that their application process will go forward and they can move in this month. We could use sponsorship for these men, about two months worth is a \$1,000 sponsorship. Let us know if you're interested meeting this need. We can even introduce you to these men and follow their process if you so desire. Sponsorship gives them the opportunity to enter into the house and start looking for work to pay the program fees on their own. Also pray that our partnership with the Lighthouse Mission would be even more strengthened, so that more men and eventually women could come from there.

We also want to clarify from the last newsletter that the Summit house **is part of the process of men and women coming off the streets, but it is the final part of that process**. After they've been through the rehabilitation process in a place like the Lighthouse Mission they need the local Church to be their place of discipleship. Summit houses help men (and we hope women in the future as well) to make that transition in a way that is sustainable so they don't relapse back into their old life.

A house has also been provided temporarily for our Lynden 2nd Summit House. We are so thankful to see more churches interested in adopting a house, since it not financially burdensome and totally about making disciples. That is the job of the Church, so that's why we are excited to partner with churches to that end! Pray this will multiply in the coming years.

We now have a tea kettle and a rice cooker! Thank you friends who donated for the Summit house.

Our friend with the tiny house is now plugged into the United Reformed Church in Lynden and working full time at Scholten's Equipment! We are blown away at what the Lord is doing. **This is a huge adjustment for this man, so pray that he can persevere in Christ through these changes as well**. These are the types of things we love to see in graduates from the Summit house. For instance, one of our graduates moved to Arizona and is getting plugged into his local church now. Another is working still, plugged into his church and doing well. Our Resident Assistant is also working hard, going to school and has been fellowshipping with the Jesus Gathering house church network. It is this kind of transformation and forward movement that we want consistently for folks connected to the Summit house and beyond.

Jesus Studies take place on Sundays now at 5pm and we've already been inviting folks to join us from the street night. **This is an exciting opportunity for potential seekers and new believers** to do discipleship with us and get to know Jesus.

Consistently **folks that visit our prayer meeting on Fridays have experienced God's presence and healing.** One man is moving forward beautifully and well connected to his new Church as well. What a blessing this time has been. Many of our street night crew come to this to be filled up in order to minister well on Tuesdays the following week.
