Even in our prayer time on Fridays we see the Lord at work. We often pray for each other and anoint folks with oil for healing and breakthrough. Pray for one man who has struggled with anxiety terribly but asks for prayer frequently as well.

Glenda Price returned for a visit to our ministry and joined us on Street Nights along with many others (she is pictured below reaching out downtown). Our desire is to share Christ and minister to those we meet while also learning from Jesus through them as well. God continues to raise up workers for the harvest on street nights. More and more folks have been coming to join us. First we do orientation with them. Sometimes we minister to needs, pass on resources and just listen. Other times we share the Gospel as the Spirit leads us and there is willingness.

On a recent street night after we finished singing, a man was intrigued by the music and we had the opportunity to share the Gospel with him for almost an hour. He shared that he believed in a Creator of some kind simply because he could see that in creation, so we

shared Christ and even about hell, judgment and our need for special revelation. We prayed that He would receive the revelation of Christ. We all hugged afterwards and parted ways with deep respect for one another.

The different groups that went out reported of praying with folks, listening to folks' stories, giving out items that could be helpful. We often realize that Jesus is still



walking with His disciples and teaching them as they go out two by two and three by three today. Feel free to join us sometime on a Tuesday night!
