Tonight on Street night the team went out two by two again. One group went to Base Camp, another to the lettered streets, another to Maritime Heritage Park and still another to the bus station. After they left I went back to my truck and heard a woman yelling loudly to herself that she had no value and that only people with nice things had value. I told her that her value didn't come from having things or from what other people think but that it comes from God. She listened, stopped talking to herself and asked me how I knew she was valuable. I told her that the blood of Christ was shed for her and that it was more valuable than anything else, then continued to share the Gospel with her. "I used to believe that to my core, but things happened..." Then two workers from Base Camp/Lighthouse Mission came behind me and started to reiterate what I was saying. She was angry at the people from Base Camp, but now they were sharing their hearts with her and she was building trust with them. For so many bridges have been burned and if they can build trust again, especially with us as believers and with the Lighthouse Mission, they can have hope again for a new life, to actually move forward, to actually believe that they are precious to God. Please pray that she will trust again and try again and believe in Christ again.

BTC SALT continues forward with more students meeting with Peter Rust. Our Men's group also meets weekly and grows in strength as well. We're so thankful for the ministries the Lord has raised up among us.
