We had another friend in ICU recently who had been a part of our program in the past. He had relapsed due to isolation from his support system and almost died. But we prayed and he is in recovery at Skagit Hospital. **Praise God for second, third and fourth chances.** He is very grateful and looking to the future God has for him.

Street night continues to be a blessing for those involved and those we minister to. Keep praying for the Gospel to go forward. We had a wonderful visit from a church from Bremerton as their youth group joined us, adding 15 to our already large group of 20-25. But what a blessing to see students praying with our friends right along with us and discussing afterwards how their eyes were opened to the plight of homelessness! We also got to host the Better Together luncheon at Bethel church this month, with other faith based non-profits in attendance.
